**NOTICE OF RACE**

The notation '(DP)' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

**1 RULES:**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and 2017 - 2021 Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats.
- 1.2 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and Supplementary Sailing Instructions that will be on the official notice board located in the PKSC.

**2 ADVERTISING:**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies (DP).

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats that comply with 2017–2021 Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats and, whose skipper and crew are financial members of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 3.2 The wearing of a lifejacket is a condition of entry in this regatta. All participants will be required to wear an Australian Standard approved personal floatation devices while racing.

**4 DIVISIONS:**

- 4.1 Racing may be conducted in seven divisions as follows:

Division 1 J	Junior classes sailing the short course (e.g. MJ's, Flying Ants)
Division 1	Small Cats (4.6m and under)
Division 2	Large Cats (over 4.6m)
Division 3	Open Mono's equal to or less than VYC yardstick 113
Division 4	Open Mono's equal to or greater than VYC yardstick 114
Division 5	Lightweight Sharpies, 505's
Division 6	B14's, 16 ft Skiffs, Foiling Moths

- 4.2 The race committee may amend division makeup dependent on race entry numbers. Amendments to division makeup will be posted on the official notice board one (1) hour prior to the first scheduled race.
- 4.3 Eligible boats are encouraged to enter online electronically through the PKSC website <http://www.pksc.com.au/> by close of business Thursday 21 November.
- 4.4 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority until 10:00 am Saturday 23th November 2019 and be subject to a late entry fee.
- 4.5 A competitor or support person automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of this Event, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said Event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.

## 5 HANDICAPS

Handicaps for the regatta will be based on the Australian Sailing Yardsticks 2018 – 19 for Off the Beach Dinghies and Catamarans or as determined by the Port Kembla Sailing Club Race Committee. The decision taken by the Race Committee is final and there shall be no request for redress accepted from such decisions.

## 6 FEES

- 6.1 Required fees for entry (plus Try booking fee) are as follows:  
Seniors - \$80.00 per boat for Regatta or \$20.00 per race.  
Juniors (18 years or under) - \$40.00 per boat for Regatta or \$10.00 per race.
- 6.2 A late entry fee of \$10.00 per boat applies.

7.3 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15:00 hrs.

**8 SAFETY INSPECTIONS**

Boats may be inspected at any time during the regatta.

**9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and may be available from the PKSC Kembla Classic Regatta website <http://www.pksc.com.au/>.

**10 VENUE:**

Racing will be conducted on Lake Illawarra adjacent to the Port Kembla Sailing Club.

**11 COURSES:**

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions. The courses may comprise of Triangle and Windward/Leeward formats. Courses may be a mix of short and long races for all divisions.

**12 SCORING:**

Five (5) races are scheduled of which two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series. When up to three (3) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When four (4) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**13 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats (DP).

**14 PRIZES**

Prizes will nominally be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places overall for the series for each division (at the discretion of the organising authority - this may change depending on the number of entries in a division).

**15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**16 INSURANCE:**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Aus. \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

**17 GENERAL INFORMATION:**

**17.1 Canteen Facilities and Meals**

Port Kembla Sailing Club operates a canteen with a limited liquor licence where good food and drinks can be purchased.

## 17.2 **Camping**

Limited camping is available on the grounds at Port Kembla Sailing Club. The club has good bathroom facilities that will be open during the event. Charges for camping will be as listed on the regatta webpage.
