

Manly Junior State Championships - Round 1



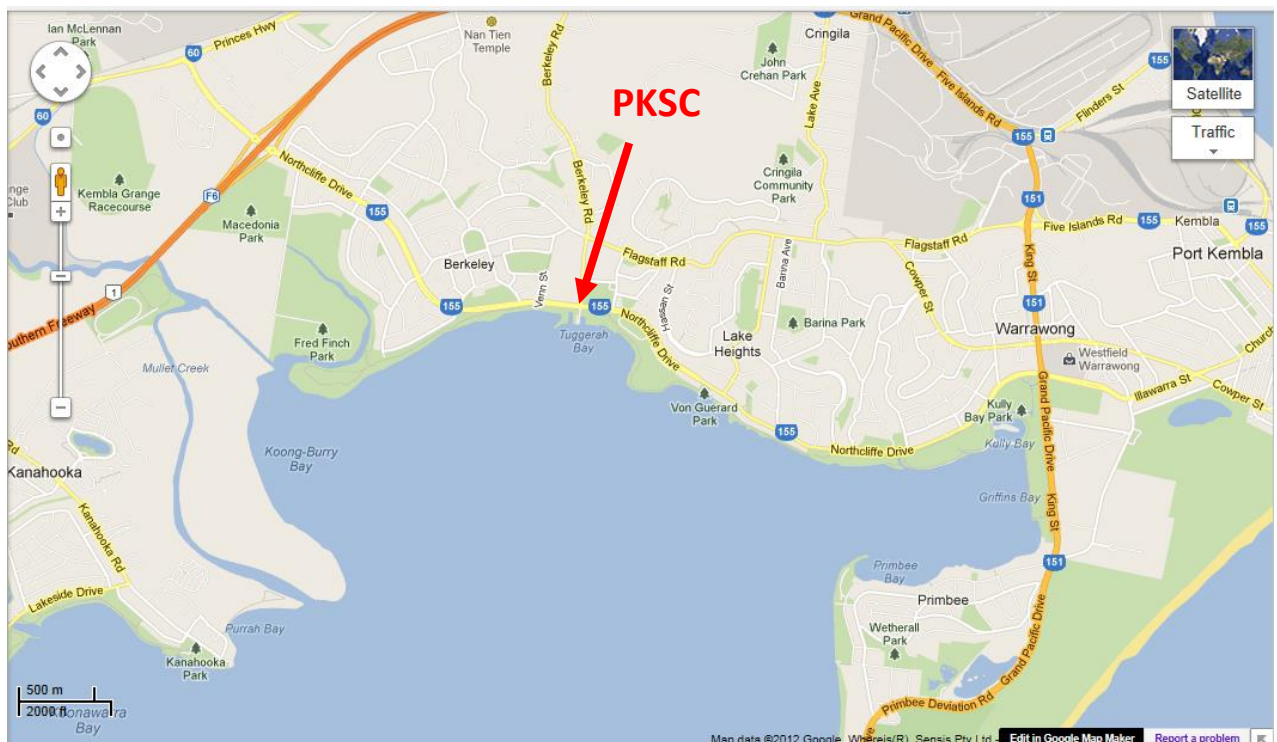
November 10th & 11th 2018



Port Kembla Sailing Club invites all registered MJ sailors and their families to participate in the First round of the State Championships to be sailed on Lake Illawarra.

Where is Port Kembla Sailing Club?

Port Kembla Sailing Club is located on Northcliffe Drive, Berkeley, on the northern side of Lake Illawarra. See map below.



Club Facilities

Port Kembla Sailing Club will be open from mid Afternoon, Friday November 9th. The club will have a designated area for camping on the club grounds at a cost of \$50/site for the weekend which are unpowered sites. Power is available inside the clubhouse if required. Generators are not to be used within the camping area. Camping fees and Saturday night dinner can be paid through the PKSC website via a trybooking page. Caravans are welcome but need to be mindful not to take up too much space, otherwise camping may become limited.

Port Kembla Sailing Club has cancelled its own sailing races for the weekend to make this a successful regatta for all those people travelling to the area.

The club has a large grassy area and there will be people on site to assist with the removal of boats, camping and parking. Cost of parking is free.

Port Kembla Sailing Club has a great licensed canteen that will be open all weekend and will be serving Bacon & Egg rolls Saturday morning, lunches Saturday and Sunday, dinner Saturday night and breakfast on Sunday. Costs of meals will be informed via the PKSC trybooking page and at the club. The club does have Eftpos facilities.

The club has toilets, showers /change rooms and a wash down area for boats when coming off the water.

The Trybooking page on the PKSC website will be set up closer to the event to book camping and dinner.

Race area

The racing area for the MJ's will be positioned on the water out the front of the club with a lot of vantage points to watch the racing on the club grounds and surrounding cycle ways.

If bringing spectator boats the club has 2 double boat ramps approx. 100m East and West of the club with plenty of water depth for launching. Both ramps have a Jetty with limited mooring room on them. It is recommended that you put your boat back on its trailer and on the grass area overnight.

Briefings and Official notice boards

All briefings, announcements and official notice boards will be located within the clubhouse.

Overnight Storage of Boats

Competitors are able to leave boats on the club grounds overnight and are encouraged to make them safe from being damaged and with no valuable items left in them.

Accommodation

If you are not camping at the club, there is plenty of other accommodation available in the area. Check out our Port Kembla Sailing Club website under the visitors section for other Illawarra accommodation.
